## Official Roadeo Rules

1. Driver must present a valid DOT Medical Card and appropriate license for the competition class at the time of registration.
2. Driver must operate from the sitting position behind the steering wheel & driver's side window must be closed to within 6" of the top.
3. **Absolutely No Riders** (except STA/Octowberfest Roadeo Officials).
4. No radio or communication equipment can be turned on while the vehicle is on the course.
5. Driver is not allowed outside the vehicle while on the course.
6. In all instances where measurements are involved, contestant **must** signal by sounding horn of his vehicle. **Measurement will not be made until horn is sounded.** Failure to use horn will result in no score for the obstacle.
7. No dogs allowed on the course.
8. Any contestant hitting the backstop or who has a collision damaging any vehicle, building, or other stationary object or injures any person on or off the course during any part of the competition will be **disqualified** and dismissed immediately. If the collision results in damage to any vehicle, building or other stationary object or injures any person on or off the competition area, the driver, his firm and/or the vehicle owner shall absolve STA of any liability.

9. At any problem with markers indicating a street, the driver must keep his vehicle with in the markers.
10. Conduct unbecoming a professional shall be grounds for **disqualification.**
11. No alcoholic beverages will be allowed on the course.
12. No contestant may take practice runs before or after the competition.
13. Every contestant must read and sign the Roadeo Entry Form.
14. No unauthorized person will be allowed on the course.
15. No harassing of any contestant while he/she is on the course.
16. Vehicles displayed in the vendor area will not be allowed on the course.
17. All tow bars; wheelifts or underlifts will be in the normal traveling position.
18. Use of foul or abusive language will result in immediate **disqualification.**
19. Contestant may not be "coached" by any means i.e. radio, cell phone, hand signals, bystander, etc. during the competition.
20. If the contestant stops a vehicle over the stop line of an obstacle, no points will be awarded for that portion of the obstacle.
21. Pertaining to the Alley Dock obstacle: any driver making a pull -up is entitled to use any distance he desires as long as he stays within the markers. After the third attempt, the driver must stop his vehicle, sound his horn and be measured.
22. Contestant must present and ready to compete when his number is called. Drivers not present when their number is called will not be allowed to compete out of rotation.

23. After completing the course, all contestants must return their assigned numbers to the scorers' booth. Scores will not be calculated if number is not turned in.
24. Violation of any Official Roadeo Rule may result in disqualification.
